Born Again

Seeley D. Kinne

The New Birth is and comes in a revelation. Jesus said to Peter, "Flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but My Father which is in Heaven." That revelation comes as the seed or Word of God. A Word which comes with spiritual life into or upon the understanding, quickening the Spirit into life, living relation to God. That one can then say, "I am 'Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.," 1 Peter 1:23.

Suddenly there flashes into the consciousness the knowledge, Why, God is my Father! I never knew it before. Now I see it. This is a miracle by the Spirit. Therefore called the Spirit of adoption, who thus operates in revelation. Rom.8: 15,16; Gal. 4:5-7.

In Titus 3:5, this, or the accompanying purifying work is called "The washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost." Washing and renewing are two sides of the new birth. In Eph. 5:25-27, we read, "Washing of water by the Word." That is, revealing light of the Spirit spoken Word of the Lord inwardly cleanses spirit and soul from its sin and defilement. This includes the initial application of the Word more or less in effect, and subsequent additional applications of the Spirit spoken Word, which should follow the first flow of the water of life, by the Word.

Jesus reproved Nicodemus for being a master or teacher in Israel and not understanding the new birth from above, for it was plainly taught in their Old Testament Scriptures, as the following: "A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh." "Who forgiveth all thine iniquities." "Create in me a clean heart, O God: and renew a right spirit within me." "All the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the Lord." It is said of Saul, "God gave him another heart." "Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart." "The Lord thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live."
